

Partial Scholarships \$5,000

Master of Integrated Water Management (MIWM)

Masters | Graduate Certificate | Graduate Diploma
Full-time or Part-time/distance*

To support future water leaders, the International WaterCentre (IWC) is offering partial-tuition scholarships (AU\$5,000) to the first 50 students who enrol in an IWC Integrated Water Management program (Masters, Graduate Diploma, Graduate Certificate) for 2013.

These scholarships are available to Australian and international students who do not receive external full-tuition scholarship or full-tuition funding from other sources.

Scholarship value

Full-time study: AU\$ 5,000 for the whole Masters program, payable per semester towards tuition fees:

- Semester 1 (Graduate Certificate) AU\$ 1,550
- Semester 2 (Graduate Diploma) AU\$ 1,550
- Semester 3 (Masters) AU\$ 1,900

Part-time study: AU\$ 5,000 for the whole Masters program payable per semester towards tuition fees (AU\$ 850 per semester).

Recipients are responsible for paying the remainder of the tuition fees each semester and all other associated expenses. The scholarship does not cover: travel, accommodation, field work, living costs, medical cover, insurance and other associated costs. These costs will be the responsibility of successful recipients.

Number of scholarships

There are 50 scholarships available for the Semester 1, 2013 intake.

Scholarship restrictions

Please read complete Terms and Conditions on IWC website:

- Available only to cover part of the tuition fees for the MIWM program (also available as Graduate Certificate and Graduate Diploma)
- Available in the year of offer only
- Available only to self-supported students** who have been offered a place in the program and have enrolled in it
- The scholarship is paid out equally over the semesters of study. The program must be completed within 3 consecutive semesters of full-time study or 6 consecutive semesters (3 years) of part-time/distance study
- This scholarship is not available with any other IWC scholarship.

About the program

The IWC Master of Integrated Water Management takes a multi-disciplinary, whole-of-water-cycle approach. It is custom-designed and taught by international practitioners and academics from four premier Australian universities.

It equips students with the integration, leadership and managerial skills to become part of an elite group of water leaders with sustainable and holistic solutions to global water and climate change challenges.

The program commences in February 2013 and can be completed in 12 or 18 months full-time or 3 years in part-time/distance*.

Entry requirements

- A completed undergraduate degree in a related field of study from an internationally-recognised institution
- Demonstrated English language proficiency
- Two years practical experience in a related field is preferred but not essential
